About the Foundation Year

The course is a healthy mix of theory and practice, including lectures, practical seminars and small group tutorials. The foundation year gives you the opportunity to study across a range of disciplines including dance & movement, drama & performance, music & sound and fine and applied arts.

- Students who enrol on this course tend to be those who are competent in multiple art forms and seek to enhance their versatility and employability within the arts. Consequently, there is a healthy blend of group and solo work, providing fertile ground for students to develop their own practice and collaborate with others.
- The work created will be experimental, seeking to challenge and investigate definitions of the arts and explore the different roles it can play.
- The skills and training acquired on this course are designed to develop students as artists who are able to make professional high-quality work that is critically engaged with.

Careers

A degree in CPA provides students with a range of transferable skills. Graduates of this course go on to a wide range of careers, including museum and heritage participatory events officers, festival curators, musicians, music producers, teachers, employment in small scale theatre and dance companies, community arts workers, theatre in education companies, regional dance officers, arts journalists, academics, self-employed artists, and in film and TV production.
