From September 2018, Carmel College is offering a range of Liverpool Hope University combined honours degree programmes.

BA (Hons) History combined

History is half of a combined honours degree. This means you combine the study of History with a second subject area such as English or Information Technology, splitting your time equally between the two subjects. This combination allows you to create a degree that is tailor made for you.

By studying history you will learn how diverse individuals, communities and societies have experienced life in the past, and gain a greater understanding of how those past experiences have helped to shape the present. You will work with different forms of historical evidence - written, visual and physical, and will become aware of the complex work in reconstructing the past.

The history course explores aspects of both modern and early modern British, Irish and European history.

First year

In the first year, you will study two key units, twentieth century European history and English history, 1530-1650. These two periods enable students to encounter a wide range of historical issues and examine different types of evidence.

Second year

You will study Nationalism and Imperialism. This examines continental European developments and Anglo-Irish relations from the 17th to the late 20th century. You will study the work of a wide range of historians and should become increasingly confident in your understanding of differing interpretations.

Third year

The final year enables you to study a selection of specialist subjects that link closely to staff research expertise. You will pursue an independent research assignment, the Special Study, in your final year.

At all levels you will analyse primary sources and the work of historians, developing your understanding of challenging ideas and concepts. This will enable you to pursue an independent research assignment in your final year.

- BA (Hons) History & Information Technology

Assessments

A variety of assessment methods are utilised throughout the degree including essays, portfolios, group work, presentations, on-line engagement and examinations.
