LEVEL 3 PROGRAMMES

A LEVELS

To access an A Level Programme, you will need to aim for grade 5s or above in your GCSEs (or equivalent).

BTEC PROGRAMME

If you choose to study a full programme of BTECs, you will need grade 4s or above at GCSE (or equivalent).

INDIVIDUAL SUBJECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Each subject has its own entry criteria, these can range from a grade 4 to a grade 7. Entry requirements can be found on the individual subject pages of the college website. Course leaflets are also available at our Open Events.

Entry requirements for all Programmes of Study will be discussed at your Guidance Interview and are negotiable on Admissions Day.

COURSE COMBINATIONS

At Carmel our timetable is very flexible enabling you to select the best combination of subjects for you. Almost any course combination is possible, including a mix of A Levels and BTECs.

For Level 3 Programmes, if you do not achieve a grade 4 in English or Maths you will need to re-sit these as part of your Programme of Study.
