

# 2025 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## General Entry Requirements (Level 3 Programmes)

The general entry requirements to study a Level 3 programme at Carmel College are as follows:

### A LEVEL STUDY PROGRAMME

5 x grade 5s or above at GCSE or equivalent\*

### BTEC STUDY PROGRAMME

5 x grade 4s or above at GCSE or equivalent\*

### T LEVEL STUDY PROGRAMME

2 x grade 5s and 3 x grade 4s or above at GCSE or equivalent

\*If you wish to combine A Level and BTEC subjects, you will need to meet the general entry requirements for an A Level study programme.

As well as meeting the general requirements above, the table below outlines the specific qualifications you will need to study individual courses.

## Course Specific Entry Requirements

ART - Fashion and Textile Design	If you have studied Art, you will need any Art & Design GCSE grade 4 or a Technology GCSE grade 4 including Resistant Materials, Product Design, Graphic Products, Textiles or equivalent.  If you haven't studied Art, no problem, you will need to provide a portfolio at interview.

Biology	Grade 6 in GCSE Biology or 66 in Combined Science plus grade 5 in GCSE Maths and grade 4 in English Language.
Business Studies	Grade 5 in GCSE Maths and GCSE English Language.
Chemistry	Grade 6 in GCSE Chemistry or 66 in Combined Science plus grade 5 in GCSE Maths and grade 4 in English Language.
Classical Civilisation	Grade 5s in GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature plus grade 4 in GCSE History if studied.
Computer Science	Grade 6 in GCSE Maths, Grade 4 in English Language and Grade 5 in Computer Science if studied.
Criminology (Level 3)	At least a Grade 4 in GCSE English Language.
Economics	Grade 6 in GCSE Maths and grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
English Language	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language and a grade 5 in GCSE English Literature (if studied).
English Language and Literature	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language and a grade 5 in GCSE English Literature (if studied).
English Literature	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language and a grade 5 in GCSE English Literature (if studied).
Film Studies	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
French	Grade 5 in GCSE French and grade 5 in GCSE English language.

# A LEVEL / BTEC / LEVEL 3 COURSE

## COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<b>Geography</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE Geography (if studied) and grade 5 in English Language and Maths.
<b>History</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE History or Humanities (if studied) and GCSE grade 5 in English Language.
<b>Law</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
<b>Maths</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE Maths.
<b>Maths (Further)</b>	Grade 7 in GCSE Maths (to be studied alongside A Level Maths).
<b>Media Studies</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language and Grade 5 in Media Studies (if studied).
<b>Physical Education</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE PE or a Merit in BTEC Sport (If studied) plus GCSE grade 5 in Science and English Language and grade 4 in Mathematics. (All applicants must be participating in a sport at club level.)
<b>Physics</b>	Grade 6 in GCSE Physics or 66 in Combined Science plus grade 6 in GCSE Maths and grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
<b>Politics</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
<b>Psychology</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language & Maths. Science requirement - grade 55 in GCSE Combined Science or grade 5 in Biology plus one more grade 5 from Chemistry or Physics.
<b>Sociology</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
<b>Spanish</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE Spanish* and grade 5 in GCSE English language. *From the higher tier GCSE paper.
<b>Statistics</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE Maths and grade 5 in English Language.
<b>Theology, Philosophy &amp; Ethics</b>	Grade 5 in GCSE Religious Studies (if studied) and grade 5 in GCSE English Language.
<b>UAL Extended Diploma in Creative Practice</b> (Extended Diploma - 3 subjects)	Any Art & Design GCSE grade 4 or a Technology GCSE grade 4 including Resistant Materials, Product Design, Graphic Products, Textiles or equivalent. If you haven't studied Art, no problem, just come and talk to one of the tutors.
<b>BTEC Business</b> (Double & Single Awards)	Grade 4 in GCSE Maths, English Language plus GCSE Business (if studied) or a Merit in BTEC First Award in Business/BTEC Technical Award in Enterprise (if studied).
<b>BTEC Health &amp; Social Care</b> (Single & Double Awards)	Grade 4 in GCSE Maths, English Language & Science and a Pass in BTEC Health & Social Care (if studied).
<b>BTEC Engineering</b>	5 x grade 5s at GCSE (or equivalent) including grade 5 in GCSE Maths and grade 5 in Physics or 55 in Combined Science plus grade 4 in English Language.
<b>BTEC IT</b> (Single Award)	Grade 4 in GCSE ICT or pass in equivalent ICT qualification (if studied) plus GCSE grade 4 in both English Language and Maths.
<b>BTEC Performing Arts (Theatre)</b> (Single Award)	Grade 4 in GCSE English Language.
<b>BTEC Psychology</b> (Single Award)	Grade 4 in GCSE Maths, English and Science.
<b>BTEC Applied Science</b> (Single & Double Awards)	Grade 4 in GCSE Maths, English and Science.
<b>BTEC Applied Human Biology</b> (Single Award)	Grade 4 in GCSE Maths, English and Science.
<b>BTEC Sport</b> (Single, Double & Triple Awards)	Grade 4 in GCSE PE or a Merit in BTEC Level 2 PE plus GCSE grade 4 in English Language, Maths and Science.
<b>T Level Education &amp; Early Years</b>	You will need at least two 5s and three 4s at GCSE including at least a 4 in English Language, Maths and Science.

### GCSE Maths & English Language

It's a government requirement that students continue to study English and Maths if they do not achieve a grade 4 in their GCSEs.
